INTRODUCTION

Param Puja Acharya Anandrishiji MS was Acharya of the Jain Shraman Sangh. He gave the message of Love, Humanity & Service to Mankind. It was his dream to establish a modern medical health care 'Arogya Mandir' (Temple of Health) for the needy, less fortunate & destitute patients.

Pujya Adarshishiji MS, a disciple of Pujya Acharya, was the source of inspiration to make this dream come true through the dedication of the team of Jain Social Federation. This dream was realised on 28th March 2001 in the form of Anandrishiji Hospital at Ahmednagar, Maharashtra. Jain Social Federation is a Public Charitable Trust registered under the Society's Act 1860 vide registration no. MAH/2377/ANR & Bombay Public Trust Act 1950 vide registration no. F-2350.

Anandrishiji Netralaya is a leading tertiary eye care center situated in Ahmednagar, Maharashtra. Established in December 2017, it has been committed to providing comprehensive eye care under one roof. The center is equipped with cutting-edge diagnostic equipment and boasts 5 dedicated modular operation theatres, ensuring a state-of-the-art experience for patients. Anandrishiji Netralaya's strength lies in its team of 18 full-time ophthalmologists, including specialists in Retina, Cornea, and Glaucoma. Since its inception, the center has performed over 75,000 eye surgeries and conducted eye checkups for more than 5 lakh patients.

Anandrishiji Netralaya goes beyond traditional hospital settings through its dedicated Community Eye Care Program. This program covers five adjoining districts, with regular eye camps conducted in rural areas. Additionally, a network of 18 operational vision centres in taluka places provides daily OPD services for primary checkups. For wider outreach, the center utilises two mobile vision vans for school eye screening and regular eye checkup camps. This commitment to community outreach ensures accessible and preventive eye care for all.

PROGRAM SCHEDULE

1ST WEEK:

Performing PHACO/SICS surgery under supervision. Observing surgical cases in the operation theatre during morning session. Audio-Visual Lecture Series on various topics related to PHACO surgery. Detailed review of the Surgical Video post-operatively. Wet-Lab practice during the afternoon session.

2ND WEEK:

Performing PHACO surgery step wise under supervision. Observing surgical cases in the operation theatre during morning session. Detailed review of the Surgical Video post-operatively. Wet-Lab practice during the afternoon session.

3RD & 4TH WEEK:

Performing PHACO surgeries independently when the surgeon gains confidence. Observing surgical cases in the operation theatre during morning session. Detailed review of the Surgical Video post-operatively. Wet-Lab practice during the afternoon session.



ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

PROGRAM DETAILS

- ▲ Eligibility : MBBS, MS/DOMS/DNB
- ▲ Duration of Program : 1 Month.
- ▲ Starting Date : 1st of Every Month.
- ▲ No. of Cases : About 20 PHACO Cases (depending on surgeon's skill level)

Only Qualified Practicing Ophthalmologist who have completed MBBS along with a Post-Graduation in Ophthalmology with MS/DNB/DO Degree from a recognized university with at least 1 year of experience in IOL Surgery. International candidates with equivalent qualifications only will be eligible for the program.

All candidates must submit the Application Form along with recent Curriculum Vitae, Supporting Documents, and Surgical Video of an IOL surgery performed by them. Applications will be reviewed by the institute and the selected candidates shall be given acceptance letter.

Candidate should have done 100 SICS & preferably 25 PHACO Surgeries.

Accommodation will be provided by the institute within close vicinity with a clean room and attached bathroom at no additional cost.
